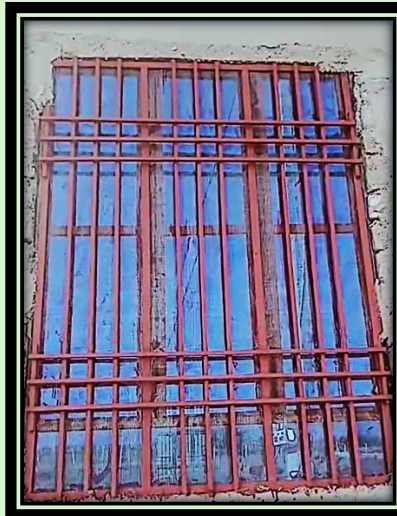

We are excited to see the building finished and dream of having it as a centre for the Faith's activities and service to the community.

The work on the roof retaining wall has started, and tiles for the flooring, bathroom, and kitchen have been selected. All this work is done under the leadership of Bajrangji and his family.





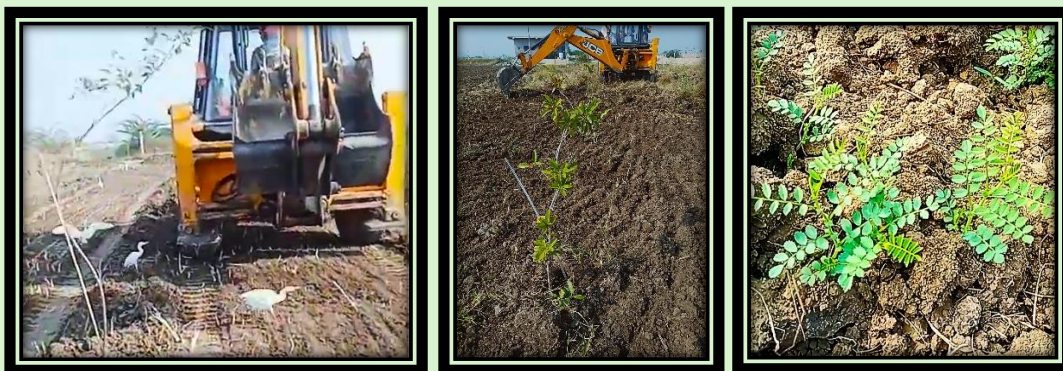
Recycling and collection of harmful materials

The young ones in Bajrangji's family removed the plastic bags and other harmful items, and soon there will be a recycling bin at Nazz Rest Home; we hope this effort can be extended to the village.



Planting more fruit trees and other crops

The work of clearing the land of deep-rooted grass has been completed using heavy machinery to prepare the ground for planting another 180 fruit trees. For the first time, we are trying to grow sugarcane. Chickpeas are this year's crop, and they are healthy and growing well. Hopefully, there will be a good crop, and the proceeds will go towards the betterment of the village.

The second irrigation pump is installed. This pump feeds the trees with rainwater collected, which is soft water and good for tender plants and trees. The well water is a little hard and not ideal for small plants. Now we have two irrigation systems to help us grow the trees and the crops. So grateful for the brave soul who went into the cold water to set the pump!

The construction of the water reservoir was prompted by a need to reinforce the property boundaries. We needed soil, so a large area about 15 feet deep was dug at the end of the property, which serves as a water reservoir and a pond to attract migrating birds.



The electricity has been restored at Nazz Rest Home

Sita Ramji filed a complaint with the electricity department regarding the damaged transformer, and a replacement was approved. The new transformer has been installed.



The plan for creating solar energy in Nazz Rest Home

Sita Ramji informed us that the government of Rajasthan offers numerous incentives for those who opt for solar energy, and he will investigate this and complete the necessary paperwork. The first step in harnessing solar energy for Nazz involves installing sufficient solar panels to ensure the water pump can operate during periods of unreliable power supply.

For those who missed the old issues of Nazz News, below are the highlights of goals and dreams for Nazz Rest Home, as well as challenges ahead.

Phase One

In this stage, the work that needs to be done includes:

Purchasing about 7 acres (7 Bhigas) of land (done)

Fencing and its reinforcement(done),

Planting hundreds of trees (done, more than 400 planted)

Digging a deep well and a water pump (done)

Improving the road to the land. (partially done)

Finally, a two-bedroom residence with a kitchen and bathroom for staying, holding meetings, and other activities (done)

Then, we will take the time to research all aspects of the project. Meanwhile, the trees will grow, and landscaping will also be improved.

Phase Two

We hope to have about 25 rooms, depending on many factors that can complicate matters (and eventually up to 100 rooms) for residents and other facilities such as a kitchen, dining hall, entertainment room, physio room, storage, etc.

We need to research many aspects of running and providing a service to protect and integrate the elderly into the community. We must follow the path of sustainability, including solar panels, filtration systems, sewage systems, electricity, and water supply. Additionally, we must consider human resources, such as doctors, physiotherapists, and other related services.

We need to establish strong relations with the villagers and the local school. The fruit gleaned from the trees is for the village. All the people are partners in the project.

We are excited and nervous, and pray that the Creator guides us through the challenges ahead.

For now, we have built a room to get electricity with a limited space for a short stay, and we may use it to stay, do some gardening, and engage in social activities.

We must consult with the authorities about various rules and regulations and navigate through some bureaucratic processes. All these challenges may take a while, and hopefully, by then, the fruit trees will have matured, and the landscape will have become beautiful.

We also need to focus on the financial side of running the place sustainably, protecting the environment, and finding ways to contribute to the betterment of the village of Chabrana, where Nazz Rest Home is situated.

There are so many things that can change, and sometimes we feel overwhelmed, but then we remember how He opened all the doors that had been closed to us.

Here are the goals or dreams we hope to achieve with the help of stakeholders and partners who desperately will need Divine Assistance:

Hopes and Dreams

- To create a process for selecting eligible candidates
- Envisioning processes of integration with different generations in the community
- To plan and execute recreational programs in the Nazz Rest Home and the community
- Consultation with experts in nutrition and other fields of healthcare
- The beautification of Nazz Rest Home Gardens to attract visitors to be part of the integration process (perhaps tours)
- Cutting-edge technology for security, monitoring and sustainability (wastewater filtration for gardens, solar panels, methods of saving water, etc.)
- Budgeting and plans for financial functioning and sustainability
- A system of transportation for the residents and staff
- To create means of communication and the use of mass media

- The use of various methods of healing, such as traditional, modern and alternative medicine
- Creating a garden of medicinal plants
- Emphasis on creating an atmosphere of spirituality for the residents
- Individualized planning and flexibility to meet the needs of the residents
- Inviting professionals and experts as guests from India and abroad who have volunteered to provide a service
- Education and training of the local people to work at Nazz Rest Home
- Maintenance of a healthy relationship with local authorities and governmental departments
- To contribute to the quality of life in the village through empowerment programs, with the goal of ownership by the locals
- Introduction of the beauty and simple life of Chabrana to the outside world through the mass media
- To plan for distributing fruits and vegetables growing in Nazz Rest Home to charitable organizations, the local school, and village residents.
- Involving the locals in maintaining and developing the gardens and buildings.
- Consult with architects to design a cutting-edge plan for a sustainable and comfortable building that meets the needs of residents and visitors.
- To strive to make Nazz Rest Home a place for holding children's classes, Junior Youth Groups, conferences and Summer or Winter Schools.
- Explore the possibility of establishing a trust fund for donations and contributions to ensure the long-term financial security and sustainability of Nazz Rest Home's operations.
- Having proper financial accounting methods and scrutinizing payments to vendors, recipients, and salaries.
- To consult with all the institutions of the Faith for guidance and spiritual support to serve the goals of the Faith.
- To set aside a few rooms for visitors from abroad who have expressed their desire to volunteer and stay for a limited period, offering their services in exchange for their stay.
