Registration of Nazz Charitable Trust with the Government of India

There has been significant progress on the Nazz Rest Home project. The most important of them all is the registration of Nazz Charitable Trust with the Government of India, and we have an account number that allows us to undertake charitable work in any field, including education, orphanages, and other areas, anywhere in India.



Nazz Transport

Now Nazz Rest Home has its own transportation: a 7-seat van called Nazz Travel. Nazz Travel is already in operation, with its logo on the back, and business cards are printed. The occasion was celebrated in the family by offering sweets.



Second Bathroom

The second bathroom is under construction by the 3-car parking lot.

Parking Lot and Traditional Shelter on the Roof

The parking lot is done and painted blue with the blue fibreglass sun protection at the back. The traditional roof shelter is rustproof and painted. The organic material for it, which grows everywhere, will be cut.



The staircase railing to the roof and the storage under the staircase for equipment are complete.

Harvest of the Chickpea Crop

The chickpeas are harvested and ready to be sold, and the proceeds will go into a separate account set aside for those who need financial assistance.



A batch of 60 more bougainvillea and other trees with beautiful flowers are being planted. The fences and irrigation system have been reinforced.

Composting Systems on the Site

Two composting systems have started. One with the organic leftover food and branches, and the other with the mixture of cow dung and other organic materials to be added to the trees as fertilizer.



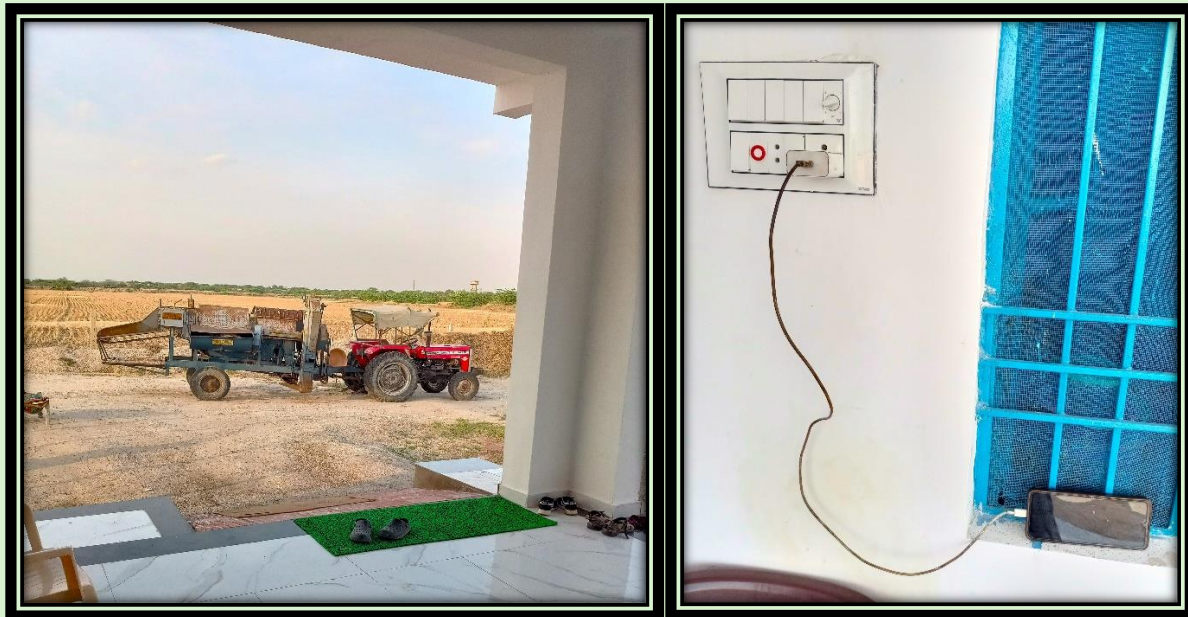
A small recycling project with a reward system has been launched with kids in one part of the village.

Recycling Plans

A plan to focus on recycling with the 260 students at the school, with an educational component and a reward system, is being designed, pending approval from the school administrators at our next meeting with them and the students.

Service to the Farmers

Nazz is already a place for farmers to park their tractors and other equipment since the village is about 3 KM away. Nazz is also a charging station for farmers' cell phones, located away from the village, with no electricity for miles except at Nazz Rest Home.



The hot water system will be brought to the kitchen and the ability to directly fill the two water tanks on the roof is being arranged. Nazz now has a cooking gas connection, a strong internet connection, a TV, an air conditioner, a laundry machine, a microwave, a fridge and a full range of utensils to make cooking easier, among many other improvements.

Community Service

The damaged water system for the village has been repaired.



New Addition to the Staffing

Nazz Rest Home has a security guard named Tappy. He is a cute little black puppy full of energy and will hopefully be trained to be loving and gentle when the elders come. Now, he chews everything, including our ankles, so he has to give them up and chew on his toys instead.



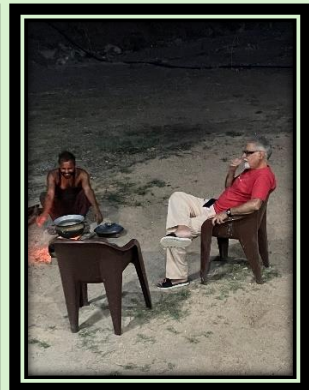
Peacock in the Village

Fishing in the Ponds

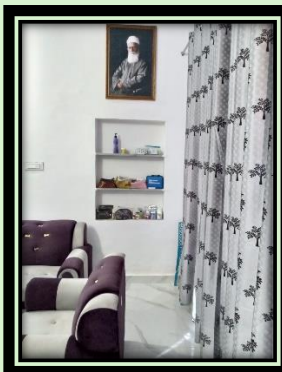

For those who missed the old issues of Nazz News, below are the highlights of goals and dreams for Nazz Rest Home, as well as challenges ahead.

Phase One

In this stage, the work that needs to be done includes:

Purchasing about 7 acres (7 Bhigas) of land (done)

Fencing and its reinforcement(done),

Planting hundreds of trees (done, more than 400 planted)

Digging a deep well and a water pump (done)

Improving the road to the land. (partially done)

Finally, a two-bedroom residence with a kitchen and bathroom for staying, holding meetings, and other activities (done)

Then, we will take the time to research all aspects of the project. Meanwhile, the trees will grow, and landscaping will also be improved.

Phase Two

We hope to have about 25 rooms, depending on many factors that can complicate matters (and eventually up to 100 rooms), for residents and other facilities such as a kitchen, dining hall, entertainment room, physio room, storage, etc.

We need to research many aspects of running and providing a service to protect and integrate the elderly into the community. We must follow the path of sustainability, including solar panels, filtration systems, sewage systems, electricity, and water supply. Additionally, we must consider human resources, such as doctors, physiotherapists, and other related services.

We need to establish strong relations with the villagers and the local school. The fruit gleaned from the trees is for the village. All the people are partners in the project.

We are excited and nervous and pray that the Creator guides us through the challenges ahead.

For now, we have built a room to get electricity with a limited space for a short stay, and we may use it to stay, do some gardening, and engage in social activities.

We must consult with the authorities about various rules and regulations and navigate through some bureaucratic processes. All these challenges may take a while, and hopefully, by then, the fruit trees will have matured, and the landscape will have become beautiful.

We also need to focus on the financial side of running the place sustainably, protecting the environment, and finding ways to contribute to the betterment of the village of Chabrana, where Nazz Rest Home is situated.

There are so many things that can change, and sometimes we feel overwhelmed, but then we remember how He opened all the doors that had been closed to us.

Here are the goals or dreams we hope to achieve with the help of stakeholders and partners who desperately will need Divine Assistance:

Hopes and Dreams

- To create a process for selecting eligible candidates
- Envisioning processes of integration with different generations in the community
- To plan and execute recreational programs in the Nazz Rest Home and the community
- Consultation with experts in nutrition and other fields of healthcare
- The beautification of Nazz Rest Home Gardens to attract visitors to be part of the integration process (perhaps tours)
- Cutting-edge technology for security, monitoring and sustainability (wastewater filtration for gardens, solar panels, methods of saving water, etc.)
- Budgeting and plans for financial functioning and sustainability
- A system of transportation for the residents and staff
- To create means of communication and the use of mass media
- The use of various methods of healing, such as traditional, modern and alternative medicine
- Creating a garden of medicinal plants
- Emphasis on creating an atmosphere of spirituality for the residents
- Individualized planning and flexibility to meet the needs of the residents
- Inviting professionals and experts as guests from India and abroad who have volunteered to provide a service
- Education and training of the local people to work at Nazz Rest Home

- Maintenance of a healthy relationship with local authorities and governmental departments
- To contribute to the quality of life in the village through empowerment programs, with the goal of ownership by the locals
- Introduction of the beauty and simple life of Chabrana to the outside world through the mass media
- To plan for distributing fruits and vegetables growing in Nazz Rest Home to charitable organizations, the local school, and village residents.
- Involving the locals in maintaining and developing the gardens and buildings.
- Consult with architects to design a cutting-edge plan for a sustainable and comfortable building that meets the needs of residents and visitors.
- To strive to make Nazz Rest Home a place for holding children's classes, Junior Youth Groups, conferences and Summer or Winter Schools.
- Explore the possibility of establishing a trust fund for donations and contributions to ensure the long-term financial security and sustainability of Nazz Rest Home's operations.
- Having proper financial accounting methods and scrutinizing payments to vendors, recipients, and salaries.
- To consult with all the institutions of the Faith for guidance and spiritual support to serve the goals of the Faith.
- To set aside a few rooms for visitors from abroad who have expressed their desire to volunteer and stay for a limited period, offering their services in exchange for their stay.
